BRUINS WIN 4 IN A ROW TO TAKE THE TITLE AT STANFORD

No. 1 USC breezed through their first game of the season and the initial three games of the Stanford Invitational but met their match against rival Bruins and defending NCAA Champs losing 1-11 in the Championship match. **Brittany Hayes** led the Women of Troy with 13 goals on the weekend.....No. 2. UCLA continues their winning streak from 2006 with four wins and the Championship at the Stanford Invitational.No. 3 STANFORD started the MPSF season with a 10-6 win over Hawaii before serving as hosts to the Nation's best at the Stanford Invitational, losing only to top ranked USC 6-8. In the game for 3rd place **Christina Hewko** led the Cardinal to victory over rival CALIFORNIA with three goals. **Meridith McColl** recorded eight saves against the Bears.....No. 4 California started the MPSF season with a win over PACIFIC and then headed across the Bay to the Stanford Invitational where they split 2-2 for 4th place in the tournament.....No. 5 HAWAII started with two conference games, defeating SAN JOSE STATE 11-9 but then bowing to host Stanford 6-11. **Kelly Mason** led the charge as the Rainbow Wahine ended up their first mainland trip with a .500 record.....No. 7 ARIZONA STATE had a slow start at Stanford losing the first three contests of the season but rebounded to down Indiana 18-7 in the 7th place match.No. 8 UC IRVINE started the season with wins over Hartwick and host Cal Baptist at the Cal Baptist Mini-Tournament. **Gianni Rossi** led the Anteaters with 7 goals for the weekend.No. 11 San Jose St warmed up with a victory over neighbor Santa Clara, lost a close one to Hawaii and highlighted the weekend with an 11-10 win over Arizona State.....No. 10 UCSB split at the Cal Baptist Mini Tournament, defeating the host Cal Baptist 9-8 and then losing to Hartwick 5-6.....No.19 CS Northridge split the weekend with a loss to host Cal State Bakersfield and a victory over Pomona Pitzer. Pacific stayed close to home but played two powerful teams losing an MPSF match to California and dropping another to UC Davis.No. 6 San Diego St and No. 16 Long Beach St start it up next weekend.
